

Abstract**Racial and Religious Discrimination in Berlin Public Schools
The Perspective of the School Social Workers**

My Human Rights Research Project was supposed to be based on a workshop in which from 5 to 10 school social workers would discuss 6 questions around racial and religious discrimination in Berlin schools. The questions focus primarily on how school social workers evaluate the situation of racial and religious discrimination in Berlin schools. However, due to difficulties explained in the report, it was impossible to hold the workshop. Instead, the Human Rights Project became based on 3 semi-structured interviews with school social workers in Berlin discussing their perspectives on racial and religious discrimination in Berlin schools and their suggestions to deal with this problem.
