Abstract

This praxis project is one of advocacy for the inclusion of Non-EU/EEA students over 30 with pre-existing conditions (N30SPEC) into Germany's statutory health insurance system, from which they are currently excluded. The project aims to secure their inclusion by submitting a petition to the German Bundestag's Petitions Committee (PCGB), highlighting legal and ethical issues with existing policies. A multi-tiered advocacy approach was explored, including the potential use of a UN Shadow Report, though maintaining the primary focus on the petition. This project emphasizes the need for equitable healthcare access for international students in Germany, ensuring their right to adequate care.
