

Abstract

The project report captures the process of an initiative called Project Green Minds. The project aimed to enhance teachers' capacities to impart Environmental Education (EE) by offering training that included an interactive method. The project targeted 5 teachers from schools of Delhi NCR, indirectly reaching 170 students on incorporating a child rights perspective, while imparting EE, focusing on climate change. Through a teachers' training workshop introducing interactive methods in the form of a worksheet, teachers were trained to engage students in discussions on environmental rights, climate change, and sustainable solutions. The worksheet, aligned with the prescribed curriculum under Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE), was used in classrooms across two schools, successfully promoting critical thinking and student engagement. Feedback from the workshops indicated increased teachers' capacity that promoted student interest in EE, suggesting further integration of rights based EE into school curriculum.
